REFRACTION

Refraction is the process used to determine a patient's sharpest vision as well as the need for a new or changed prescription. A refraction also provides important information allowing the doctor to evaluate the need for medical or surgical treatment. It is a necessary part of an ophthalmic examination, but the refraction is not a covered service by Medicare and most insurance companies. Our office fee for the refraction is \$40.00 and this fee is collected in addition to any co-payment, co-insurance, or deductible at the time of service.
