Within his March 14, 2020 update on the COVID-19 virus pandemic, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine issued new suggested guidelines for dental health care workers.

The new guidelines are in direct response to two immediate realities:

1. A national shortage of barriers (masks, face shields, gloves) necessary for proper protection in general health care settings.
2. The desire to minimize the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

I am in support of the Governor's request. It would be inappropriate for us to pull away from the limited barrier supplies that are desperately needed on the front lines of the COVID-19 management.

For the immediate future our services here at the dental office will be limited to the following:

1. Anything you consider an emergency
2. Traumatic injury
3. Any patient with oral and/or neck pain
4. Broken teeth
5. Missing fillings
6. Crown off
7. Evaluation and treatment of unexplained swelling or bleeding
8. Planning and consultation regarding future treatment.
