General Wound Care Instructions

- •Cleanse the wound daily with mild soap and cool water.
- Apply Polysporin to the area 3X's per day. DO NOT LET CRUST.
- •If possible, keep a bandage or gauze cover over the wound until it has healed.
- •If you have sutures in place, do not allow the wound to soak in a pool, hot tub or bathtub. Brief exposure to water in a shower is acceptable.
- •Avoid strenuous activity for 24 hours after procedure. Minimize activity which puts strain on the sutures.
- •If you notice any signs of infection (fever, pus or redness spreading out from the wound) please call our office.
- •Most patients have little or no discomfort. If needed Tylenol® is acceptable.
- •There is always a possibility of scarring with any surgical site. If your scar becomes thick or begins to itch, please contact our office as it may require treatment.
