Other times, you need more intricate work, like a crown or a root canal. However, many patients in and around the Keller area have streamlined their search. From a child’s first visit to a senior’s smile restoration, from a routine cleaning to complex cosmetic dentistry, even sleep apnea and TMJ concerns, the team at Blue Stone Dental provides comprehensive dental care all under one roof.

Maybe you’re just days away from going out of town for a 20-year high school reunion or a business trip with major clients. No matter how much preparation you put into your big trip, it only takes one bite on a tiny popcorn kernel at the movies to chip a tooth. You could white-knuckle it until you get back into town, but the pain and unsightliness of a damaged tooth is probably more than you can bear.

Then again, fixing a chip or crack could take more time in the dentist chair than you have. There’s the examination, the goopy and uncomfortable impression, milling of the crown, the clumsy temporary and the actual restoration. Tack on more time if you need a root canal to prepare the affected area. If someone told you that your cracked, chipped or decayed tooth can be restored—root canal and all—in just one day, you’d probably laugh aloud (*if your tooth didn’t hurt so much*).

What would normally take at least three appointments, Blue Stone Dental can take care of in one. It’s made possible with CEREC technology. Drs. Lauck and Corley can make a digital impression and mill a crown instantly, not in some off-site lab. You won’t have to endure a temporary crown, get additional anesthetics, or come back for more appointments, regardless of whether you need one tooth restored or several.

“You won’t have to worry that you will lose a temporary or miss a big event. You can come in the morning, and we can take care of the root canal and crown that same day,” says Dr. Corley. With CEREC technology, he also assures the superiority of its fit. “Most porcelain work is made from a powder, so there’s shrinkage and it is porous. Our crowns are milled out of solid porcelain.” And because the digital impression is three-dimensional, the crown is designed to fit the patient’s teeth perfectly in every dimension. “When designing the crown, we can even account for any appliance used by the patient, for TMJ or sleep apnea, for example,” says Dr. Lauck. The result is the most stable, most natural-looking and safest restoration available.

Safety is key. Metal crowns and fillings were once common in dentistry, but the ill effects of metal

have since been widely recognized. Patients’ health and safety have always been a top priority at Blue Stone Dental. “We offer a metal-free facility. There’s no mercury here, never has been. We want to ensure that there’s no contamination, so we take special precautions to take out old mercury fillings and to not re-expose or contaminate their bodies, either through inhaling or swallowing,” says Dr. Lauck.

It would seem like a logical expectation that dentists naturally look out for patients’ well-being, but there’s much more to dental care than looking inside someone’s mouth. Some call it “bedside manner.” Others simply call it “listening.” Face



it, we’ve all encountered health professionals with a tin ear for our concerns, but Drs. Lauck and Corley pride themselves on truly hearing out their patients.

The simple act of listening helps patients feel involved in their own care, and it seals that all-important doctor-patient relationship that’s so critical for long-term health.

Drs. Corley and Lauck are most certainly in it for the long haul, not just for their patients, but for the community they serve.
