Answers to FAQs

- 1. Emergencies may necessitate a change in the schedule, but the surgeon will make every effort to accommodate your schedule.
- 2. All surgery carries some associated risks and complications. Educational brochures or videos may help you understand these issues more clearly.
- 3. Dr. Lowe performs all procedures himself. He will notify you if students plan to observe the case or assist him for educational purposes.
- 4. Dr. Lowe and his staff are committed to being available for all emergencies or questions following surgery. However, if Dr. Lowe is out of town or involved in another case, one of his colleagues or his private nurse or P.A. may have to assist until he is available.
- 5. Cosmetic surgical quotes are largely based on estimated length of surgery. Fees may be different for different people because each individual's surgery has particular issues that may make the surgery or procedure more or less complex.

Please Note:

- 1. Only procedures deemed safe, appropriate, and beneficial for the patient are performed in Dr. Lowe's Cosmetic and General Plastic Surgery practice. Dr. Lowe may be unable to provide the service requested.
- 2. We maintains a strict no smoking policy for the benefit of patients. All elective and cosmetic patients should stop smoking at least 6 weeks prior and after surgery. The surgeon may in some instances elect not to perform the surgery due to a smoking history.
- 3. Surgical dates cannot be guaranteed until Dr. Lowe and the patient have agreed on the specific surgical plan, and the office has set and collected all cosmetic fees, if indicated. Cosmetic patients are required to place \$500 fee to hold a future surgical spot. Patients must pay fees in full 2 weeks prior to surgery.
- 4. Two plastic surgical consultations are preferred before cosmetic surgery is scheduled. The purpose of the second visit is to provide patients with the opportunity to ask questions and clarify expectations.
- 5. The cosmetic surgery patient's second visit is included in the consultation fee, as long as it is for the same problem within 1 year of the first visit.
- 6. Confidential preoperative and postoperative photographs are required of all patients. They are used for insurance purposes, to formulate a surgical plan, and to evaluate results.

- 7. Pre-surgical evaluation, including blood work, EKG, or chest x-ray, and a medical consultation may be required.
- 8. Dr. Lowe can usually provide you with photographs of patients who have undergone a similar procedure or surgery.

Important Cosmetic Surgery Payment Information:

- 1. An official surgical quote will be provided at time of pre-payment. This is a cash or check discounted fee is not negotiable, but if an error is noted, please let us know. Patients who choose to finance surgery will be charged the appropriate financing fees typically 2-5%.
- 2. The surgical quote is an estimate and may be subject to change, particularly if your case is rescheduled at a later date. The hospital or facilities reserve the right to increase fees at any time until final payment is made. Some fees may be incurred beyond those on the sheet.
- 3. Payment for anesthesia and professional fees are required two weeks in advance of surgery in our office, and services rendered for complications or revisions are not included in the original payment.
- 4. If you fail to cancel a pre-op consultation 48 hours in advance, a fee may be added to your next scheduled visit.
- 5. If you fail to cancel your surgery 10 days in advance, without legitimate medical reasons, half of the professional fee may be retained by the office without future credit.

Summary:

Dr. Lowe's primary goal is to provide excellent clinical results along with a high-level of patient care and service. It is important that every cosmetic surgery patient evaluated understands that cosmetic surgery is something you "want" not something you "need." He wants all patients understand the risks and potential complications of reconstructive, emergent, and elective surgery.
