

CHEMICAL PEEL AFTER CARE INSTRUCTION

Early:

- 1. Antibiotics and pain medication should be taken as directed.
- 2. Most of your discomfort will be within the first 4-8 hours after the peel, while most of your swelling will be within the first 3 days.
- 3. Bacitracin ointment or other gel is to be applied lightly to the area 3 times a day for the first 5 days only. Following this, apply a 0.5% hydrocortisone cream (available over-the-counter) to the times a day for the next 3 days only. (This helps to decrease the redness and irritation).
- 4. Cold moist compresses help cleanse and soothe the area. These should be applied 4-6 times a day. You may splash cool water on your face several times a day. Pat dry gently, then apply the ointment.
- 5. Most crusting and peeling occurs within 5-7 days.
- 6. Hypoallergenic moisturizers and cosmetics may be applied after healing is complete, about 7-10 days after the peel.
- 7. Normal skin care routines may be resumed 7-10 days following the procedure.
- 8. Your skin is fresher and smoother at this time. It is also more susceptible to the sun's damaging rays and very prone to sunburn. Please apply sun block <u>SPF 20</u> or greater for at least the first 6 months, even on cloudy days.
- 9. Your first follow up visit will be approximately 5-7 days after the peel. Do not hesitate to call if you have any questions or problems before then.

Late:

- 1. Direct and indirect sunlight should be avoided for at least 12 months.
- 2. Sunscreen with SPF 20 or greater should be applied daily.
- 3. Moisturizing creams should be used daily.
