Please keep in mind that teeth shift slightly throughout your adult life. Unfortunately, this is a natural part of the aging process. Usually, this minor shifting is first noticed in the lower front teeth area. Please make sure you check your teeth regularly and pay attention to how tight your contacts feel when you floss your teeth.

If you have any concerns in the future, please feel free to contact our office to schedule an appointment. Examples of concerns would be:

- Shifting of the upper or lower teeth
- A feeling like your bite is not quite right
- Excessive contact of the upper and lower front teeth
- Unusual bone or gum recession
- Jaw joint popping, sounds, stiffness or facial muscle soreness
- Your dentist feels that you need to see us again
