

Pre-Comprehensive Report Letter

- At your next appointment, we are going to take a new x-ray of your teeth and jaw structures. The doctor will compare it to your original x-ray.
- This will allow us to determine if the roots of the teeth are positioned properly in the bone and whether any root shortening or bone/gum recession is present.
- We will also be able to see your wisdom teeth and their development if they are present.
- We will continue to assess your oral hygiene and brushing and give you a good idea on how much time is remaining your orthodontic treatment.
- We may also be placing new wires at this appointment that are a little “tighter” than you are used to. We recommend taking Ibuprofen prior to your next visit, if possible.
- Also, since we will be taking an x-ray, please try not to wear excessive earrings or facial jewelry to the appointment.
- We will review with you (and your guardian if you are a minor) all of the above findings at your next appointment and answer any questions that you have.
