Based upon all the evidence, the jury's answers to the Special Verdict Form and all of the files, records and proceedings herein, the Court makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACTS

1. Defendant Samuel Patrick Donegan, M.D., as an agent of Aspen Medical Group, P.A., was negligent in his care and treatment of Plaintiff Meshell Davis.

- 2. Defendant Samuel Patrick Donegan, M.D.'s negligence in that care and treatment was a direct cause of the injury to Plaintiff Dhevyn Blackburn.
- 3. Defendant Samuel Patrick Donegan, M.D.'s percentage of fault in directly causing the injury to Plaintiff Dhevyn Blackburn is 90 percent.
- 4. The amount of money that will fairly and adequately compensate Plaintiff Meshell Davis and Plaintiff Dhevyn Blackburn for past and future damages is \$ 15,525,148.50.00.

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Court makes the following:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Plaintiff Meshell Davis and Plaintiff Dhevyn Blackburn are entitled to judgment in their favor, together with costs and disbursements necessarily incurred in this matter.

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. That judgment be entered in favor of Plaintiffs, and against Aspen Medical Group, P.A., and Samuel Patrick Donegan, M.D., in the amount of \$ 13,972,633.65, together with costs and disbursements necessarily incurred in this matter.
- 2. That pursuant to Minnesota Rule of Civil Procedure 58.02, the entry of judgment in this matter is hereby stayed for 30 days.
